Most of the poems deal with the supernatural or uncanny, but also reflect the glories of the Shropshire countryside. A warrior's spear is charged with the power of lightning on the Stiperstones; a strange presence on Black Rhadley Hill guards a highwayman's gold; a husband seeks for his lost wife in the Dance of Death on Adstone Hill; the owner of Walcot Hall has a frightening encounter in a mock-Indian temple; 'Mad Jack' Mytton is pursued by the 'Seven Whistlers' of Shropshire folklore; Fulke Fitz Waryn's skull is unearthed in an old farmhouse. In a blend of the Gothic and modern, historical characters enter an alternative reality, and new stories, laced with myth and legend, are born from the Shropshire landscape itself.
