Eventually, on 1st June, I sailed for Bombay by the P. and O. Massilia, a 10-knot paddle steamer of 1640 tons and 400 h. p., considered rather a good ship in those days. Though pokey and stuffy in comparison with the boats of modern times, things were done far more liberally then than in these days of competition, and if fares were high --first class, Southampton to Bombay, being about...
